Academic Year 114(2025) Curriculum Plan for Incoming Students, Department of Information and Library Science

Starting from the 2025 academic year, newly admitted students will follow a General Education curriculum structure totaling **26** credits. The curriculum is divided into three categories: Basic Competence, General Education Curriculum, and Service and Activity Courses.

I. Basic Competence (12 credits)

- (1) Language Expression (10 credits)
--Ability of Expression in Spoken and Written Chinese (2 credits)
--Foreign Language Q (8 credits):
Freshman English (4 required credits: 2 per semester)
Sophomore Foreign Language (4 required credits: 2 per semester)
- (2) Learning and Development (N), Learning in University (1 credit)
- (3) Extracurricular Activities and Teamship Development (K), The Operation of Students' Clubs and Team Development

II. General Education Curriculum (12 credits)

1. Required: Introduction To Artificial Intelligence (1 credit)
2. Required: Exploring Sustainability (1 credit)
3. Humanities Field (at least 2 credits): Appreciation of Chinese Literature (L), History Studies (P), Philosophy and Religion (V), Arts Appreciation and Invention (M)
4. Social Sciences Field (at least 2 credits): Global Outlook (T), Futures Studies (R), Social Analysis (W), Civil Society and Participation (S)
5. Science Field (at least 2 credits): Information Education (O), Global Technology Revolution (Z), Natural Sciences (U)
6. Note: The same course cannot be taken more than once; a maximum of two courses (4 credits) can be taken in each sub-domain.

III. Service and Activity Courses

1. Male and Female Physical Education (4 credits, excluded from graduation credit count)
2. All-Out Defense Education Military Training (I)-National Defense Technology (1 credit, excluded from graduation credit count)
3. Campus and Community Service-Learning (**1/1 credits**)
